

**NOTICE REGARDING TURNOVER OF FUNDS FROM FINAL DISTRIBUTION
CHECKS NOT CASHED WITHIN 30 DAYS AND PROCEDURES FOR OBTAINING
FUNDS FROM CLERK OF COURT**

On November 20, 2009, the Crown Paper Liquidating Trust made its final distribution to holders. Pursuant to procedures for wind up of the Trust approved by the Court by order entered October 7, 2009, the checks for such distribution were required to be cashed within 30 days. The checks were sent with a notice that all such checks were required to be cashed within 30 days. 30 days passed from that distribution and the Trust closed the account on which the checks were drawn. On December 23, 2009, also in accord with the procedures approved by the Court, the Trust turned over to the Clerk of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of California, San Francisco Division (hereafter referred to as "Clerk of the Court"), the funds from all checks that were not cashed.

The Trust has posted on this web site a copy of its "Notice of Turnover of Trust Funds to the Clerk of the Court" that was filed with the Court along with the turn over to the Clerk of the Court of the funds in respect of checks that were not cashed. The exhibit to such Notice as docketed shows the names, addresses and amounts of holders of checks not cashed by claimant name listed alphabetically. The funds remain available from the Clerk of the Court for a period of five years upon submission to the Clerk of the Court by a holder who/which did not cash his/hers/its check of an "Application for Unclaimed Dividends" requesting payment of such funds. A copy of the required "Application for Unclaimed Dividends" including the instructions has also been posted on this web site for the use and convenience of holders desiring to obtain payment from the Clerk of the Court.

Each claimant for the funds must complete the "Application for Unclaimed Dividends" by filling in the blanks and checking the applicable boxes on the Application, signing the Application and by filling in the blanks on the form of Court Order. The claimant must then submit the Application, the completed Order, proof of identity, a complete copy, including the two exhibits, of the Trust's "Notice of Turnover of Trust Funds to the Clerk of the Court" and all other documentation as indicated in the instructions by mailing all required documents to the Clerk of Court at the following address: **United States Bankruptcy Court, Post Office Box 7341, San Francisco, CA 94120-7341, Attention: Toni Taylor.** In addition, a copy of the completed Application must be mailed by the claimant to the **US Attorney for the Northern District of California, 450 Golden Gate Avenue, Post Office Box 36055, San Francisco, CA 94102.** The blanks in the Application will require the insertion of the name, address, social security number (or tax identification number), telephone number, email address (if any) and the date of the mailing to the US Attorney. The blanks in the Order must be completed with the insertion in the blanks (several times) of the claimant's name, address and amount claimed. **The Trust cannot complete the Application for a claimant and cannot obtain the funds on behalf of a claimant.**
